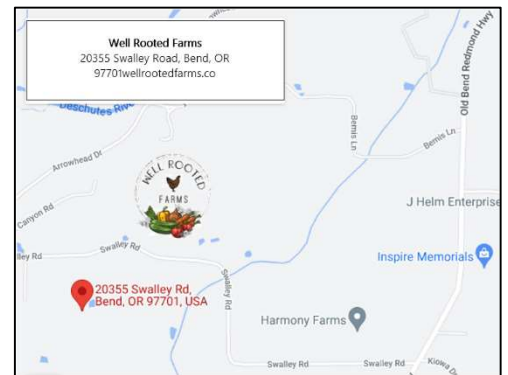




# COBKA END-OF SUMMER FIELD DAY AND PICNIC
