- 10 Uniformity of filling exhibit (added labels)
- 20 Variety flavor, down-grade for objectionable flavor, over heating, fermentation

# COMB HONEY, CUT COMB & FRAMES

<b>Points</b>	Description
35	Uniformity of color & appearance
20	Absence of uncapped cells & watery capping, cut comb neatness
20	Cleanliness of section or frame
10	

- 10 Lack of granulation & pollen
- 15 Uniformity of weight (except frame)

## CHUNK HONEY

#### Points Description

- 20 Neatness of cut, size uniformity
- Absence of watery capping, uncapped & pollen cells
- 20 Cleanliness, travel stain, foreign matter flakes of wax, foam, debris
- 30 Uniformity of appearance & capping color & thickness of comb

# **CREAMED HONEY**

## Points Description

- 35 Fineness of crystals
- 25 Uniformity & firmness
- 25 Cleanliness & lack of foam
- 25 Flavor, Down-grade for off flavor, over heating, fermentation

# **BEESWAX (one piece)**

#### **Points Description**

- 30 Color & odor straw, canary, shades of yellow
- 35 Cleanliness, Downgrade for impurities
- 20 Uniform appearance
- 15 Freedom of cracking

## **BEESWAX CANDLES**

#### Points Description

- 30 Color, odor & brightness
- 35 Cleanliness, Downgrade for impurities
- 15 Lack of cracks or blemishes
- 20 Uniformity of appearance

# ARTISTIC BEESWAX

#### <u>Points Description</u>

- 35 Creativity & appearance
- 30 Cleanliness, no impurities
- 20 Variety in colors
- 15 Stability of design

# **BEEKEEPING PHOTOGRAPHY**

## Points Description for Subject Category

- 20 Follows theme (Fair Theme, Bees & Their Keepers, Bees/Bee Colonies at Work)
- 20 Balance
- 30 Color contrast
- 30 Presentation

## HONEY JUDGING SCORING GUIDELINES

## Points Description for Honey itself

- -20 Large debris, e.g., grass, whole bees, wood splinters
- -15 Medium debris, e.g., hair, long lint pieces
- -10 Small debris, e.g., many particles of lint, bee parts
- -10 Specks of dirt
- -15 Prolific crystallization
- -10 Some crystallization
- -05 Minimal crystallization
- -10 Many or large wax particles
- -05 A few wax participles
- -02 A wax particle
- -02 A few pieces of lint
- -02 Air bubbles
- -02 Pollen pieces

#### Points Volume of Honey in Jar

- -01 Per jar. Over fill.
- -03 Per jar. Under fill.
- -02 Per jar. Uneven fill.
